• Village Rd:

- Looked at the new culvert and road surface
- o There is a small section in the Anderson yard where dirt has washed, this should be filled in
- o Road surface needs attention. This was discussed with Derek Olinger from Bolton & Menk last fall. A core sample was done last fall but has not been picked up by Olinger

• Oakview Loop:

 Chiglo stated he does not agree with Derek Olinger-Bolton & Menk that the whole road needs to be completely redone. Chiglo stated he feels the road is not in that bad of shape and feels a chipseal or double chipseal would be all that is needed which would be a large cost savings

• Gilbertson Rd:

- o Looked at the repairs made to the stream bank after the June 2024 flood event
- o Rip rap was placed to hold the stream bank
- o FEMA grant money was received for the project

• Vogan/Dunn:

- o Looked at the culvert Chiglo installed on Dunn. Chiglo will be extending the length
- o Chiglo stated he will be reshaping the road where Vogan and Dunn meet. Right now there is a Y, he will be removing the Y by filling the grass part with gravel and reshaping the road so water will run off properly
- o Ruberg asked if this would make the road narrower in that spot. Chiglo stated it would not. Ruberg stated the road should remain the same width because that is a spot semis are parked when field work is being done
