

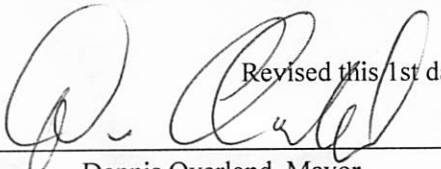
## City of Rushford Village Dust Control Policy

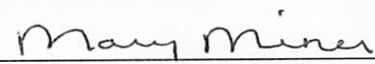
Approved 3/17/2026, Revised 9/1/2026

The City of Rushford Village (CRV) will provide reimbursement for dust control to CRV residents who live on a gravel road.

- Reimbursement Rate: \$.30 per foot up to 500 feet per application
- Applications: 2 allowed per year, spring and fall
  - First application must be after May 31<sup>st</sup>
  - Second application cannot be after September 30th
- CRV Resident Responsibility:
  - Hire dust control vendor
  - Contact CRV at 507-864-7974 at least 2 weeks before product will be placed on the road to allow CRV time to prep the road if needed. This would require a call before each application
  - If road is going to receive rock in the spring the citizen will be made aware of this by the CRV Maintenance Supervisor, resident should wait until rock has been delivered and spread before applying dust control. CRV will not be responsible for rock being placed over areas with dust control if dust control is applied before rock is delivered and spread
  - Drop off/mail paid dust control receipt to: CRV at 43038 State Highway 30, Rushford Village, MN 55971 before December 15 of the year the dust control was applied.
  - If two applications, both receipts can be turned in together after the second application
  - Receipt for each application must include:
    - Name of Vendor
    - Name of resident
    - Address of resident
    - Date of application
    - Invoice/Ticket Number
    - Number of feet product applied
    - Receipt signed by the CRV Resident
  - If the road is maintained by Fillmore County the CRV resident must contact Fillmore County and follow their regulations pertaining to their roads in regards to dust control. To get reimbursement from CRV the resident must follow the above CRV requirements regarding when the receipt has to be turned in by and what is required on the receipt
- CRV will not maintain sections of roads where dust control has been applied between June 1 and October 1 other than to prep road for second application if needed and if there is an issue with potholes, road erosion or any other circumstance that would be a safety concern. A courtesy call will be made to the resident before grading.
- CRV will mail a check to the address on the dust control receipt within one month of receiving the dust control receipt for reimbursement
- Failure to follow the CRV Dust Control Reimbursement Policy will result in reimbursement being denied
